Party Planning Tips

The individual class coordinators are independent of the Mount de Sales Office of Institutional Advancement and do all the work in organizing and planning their event. MDS advancement staff members provide administrative assistance, mail reunion invitations, and accept reunion payments by individual class members. We also provide special gifts to classes celebrating 25th and 50th reunions.

There are many aspects of planning which will ensure the success of your event. For example, two of the most important things to do are to keep the cost low and generate excitement about the event. In addition, a cash bar and requiring registration payments prior to the event are two best practices that all committees should implement.

Choosing the venue will take the most time. Event spaces book up early and may have limited capacity this year, so make your decisions about location as soon as possible. The ultimate cost saver is to hold the event at the home or business of a local classmate.

Examples of Class Activities:

Registration Table:

You will want to have a table to check guests in where they can update contact information and pick up a nametag. In addition, you may want to set-up a nostalgia table with old yearbooks, invitations, uniforms photos, etc.

Class Giving

MDS has a wonderful legacy of generosity, and each class benefitted from donations made by other alumni and friends of the school. We encourage classes to use their reunion year as a time to make a special gift back to the school they love so as to enhance the educational experience of our current Cavaliers.

Advancement staff can work with classes to choose a project that is of particular interest or honors/memorializes a former teacher or classmate. There are opportunities to name classrooms and areas of the athletic complex and field house. We also provide donation options that are available to each classmate when they register for the reunion including:

• Alumni Scholarship Fund

Each year, an outstanding senior is selected to receive a \$500-\$1,000 scholarship to help with college tuition or expenses.

• 150th Alumni Archives Project

In celebration of MDS' sesquicentennial anniversary in 2026, we are planning a permanent display throughout the school of our extensive archival collection. Funds are needed for display cases, archival expertise, and exhibit design.

• Spirit of Mercy Annual Fund

Gifts to this fund are deployed where needed most to enhance the programs, technology, and facilities used by every student.

• Trees at Cavalier Fields

At the initiation of an alumnus of the class of 1981, we created a master plan to add trees to Cavalier Fields. Trees can be purchased and installed for between \$350-\$750 and can include a plaque recognizing the class.

July 15-31	MDS mails class invitations	
July – September	Coordinators complete reunion party logistics and informs classmates of changes/details	
	Organizers encourage classmates to register for the event online and contribute to the class gift	
September 10	Online registration for parties closes. Organizers can decide whether to accept registrations/payments at the door	
September 15	MDS staff confirms all event plans, registrations, and gifts with coordinators; provides check to coordinator covering amount of registrations	
September 23-26	Cavalier Celebration During or after the event, please post pictures and tag us on social media using <u>#mdscavcelebration2022</u>
