HOPE Scholarship Requirements

HOPE –

- Georgia resident
- Academic GPA of 3.0 as calculated by GSFC
- 4 rigor credits
- No SAT/ACT requirement
- College eligibility – Maintain a 3.0 GPA
- Pays roughly 75% of tuition

Zell Miller Scholarship –

- Georgia resident
- Academic GPA of 3.7 as calculated by GSFC
- 4 rigor credits
- SAT – 1200 (EBRW/M) or ACT – 26 Composite
- College eligibility – Maintain a 3.3 GPA
- Pays roughly 100% of tuition

How to apply:

- If the student only wants to receive the HOPE Scholarship , then they may complete the [GSFAPP](#).
 - If the student wants to receive HOPE in addition to Federal Aid, such as grants and/or student loans, then the student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid ([FAFSA](#))
 - The Financial Aid Office at the college where the student is attending will use the test scores on file to determine if the student is eligible for the Zell Miller Scholarship.
